REGISTERING TO VOTE

Who can register to vote?

There is no waiting period to register to vote. Eligibility requirements are as follows:

- Be a United States citizen
- Be a resident of Athens-Clarke County, Georgia
- Be 17 1/2 years of age to register, 18 to vote
- Cannot currently be serving a sentence for a felony conviction.
- Cannot be adjudicated to be mentally incompetent.

How to register

You can obtain a voter registration application at any public library, social service agency, city hall or the voter registration office. You can also obtain the form from the Secretary of State's website at www.sos.state.ga.us/elections. Print the application. Complete and sign the application and mail to:

Registration Deadlines

All new registrations and changes must be received in the election office or postmarked 30 days prior to an election to be in effect for that election.

Uniformed and overseas voters

There are special provisions in state and federal law that apply to these voters.

To access federal voting information : www.FVAP.gov

Once you have registered and requested a ballot, you will automatically be mailed ballots for the federal election year. Therefore, it is the voter's responsibility to update the registration office of any change in information such as name and/or address.

College students living away from home

College students who still consider themselves residents of their home county should register using their home address. They may list their address at school as their mailing address. Absentee ballots can be mailed to a student living in Athens while attending school.

All colleges and universities in Georgia offer voter registration and absentee ballot information through their student services offices.

ELECTION DAY INFORMATION

Polling hours

All polling locations are open from 7:00am until 7:00 pm on election day. You may vote any time during those hours, and if you are in line to vote at 7:00 pm you will be allowed to vote.

What to bring with you on election day

Georgia law requires voters to show one of six forms of photo identification in order to vote in person (O.C.G.A. § 21-2-417).

The following items are acceptable forms of identification:

1. A Georgia driver's license, even if expired
2. Any valid state or federal government-issued photo ID, including a **FREE** Voter ID card issued by your county registrar's office of the Department of Driver Services (DDS)
3. Valid U.S. passport
4. Valid employee photo ID from any branch, department, agency or entity of the U.S. Government, Georgia or any county, municipality, board, authority, or other entity of this state.
5. Valid U. S. military photo ID
6. Valid tribal photo ID

Note: If a voter is unable to provide one of the above, the voter will be allowed to cast a provisional ballot. The voter will then have 48 hours to provide either the ID or a legible copy to the elections office. If the voter fails to provide the ID within the time specified, the ballot will not be counted.

Special identification requirement for first time voters who register by mail.

Federal law requires that you include a copy of one of the acceptable ID's with your application. If you fail to provide the identification, you may only cast a provisional ballot, which can be counted later but only after your eligibility has been determined.

How can I work at the polls?

Obtain a Poll Worker application from the Board of Elections office at 155 E. Washington Street, Athens, Georgia.

Where do I vote?

Look at your precinct identification card to locate your polling site. Listed below are all of the polling locations for Athens-Clarke County for election year 2008.

Type of voting equipment
 Georgia has a statewide voting system called DRE or Touch Screen. Voters do not have to vote every position on the ballot for the ballot to count. If only one race is voted upon, that one vote will count. To see a demonstration of the equipment, visit our office at 155 E. Washington Street, Athens Georgia.

How can I find out about running for office?
 For state and federal offices, you must contact the Secretary of State’s office at 404 656-2871 or visit www.sos.state.ga.us. For county and state judicial office, contact Athens-Clarke Board of Elections office at 706 613-3150.

Absentee/Advanced Voting
Early Absentee Voting—No excuse needed! Beginning at least 45 days before a General Election (Monday-Friday), visit the Board of Elections office, fill out the application, and present one of the permitted forms of photo ID. For large elections, satellite voting sites are available.
Absentee Voting By Mail—No excuse needed! Simply complete an application and mail or fax to the Board of Elections. We urge you to request your mail-in ballot and get it back to the Board of Elections office as soon as possible.

An absentee ballot does not require an official form; however, the request **must** include the date or specific election for which you are requesting your ballot, the address to which you would like your ballot mailed, your signature and your date of birth so we may verify your information in the state system..

If you are disabled, 75 years or older, and/or a member of the Armed Forces or Merchant Marines of the United States or a spouse or dependant living outside the county or municipality in which the election is held, you may choose to submit on application and receive a ballot for the Primary, Primary Runoff, Election and Election Runoff. You must, however, let us know if you meet any of the aforementioned criteria and would like to request all absentee ballots as allowed by law. We will not automatically mail all ballots to you.

RETURN OF ABSENTEE BALLOTS BY MAIL OR PERSONAL DELIVERY Georgia Election Code Section 21-2-385 states that “the elector shall then mail or PERSONALLY DELIVER same to the board of registrars or absentee ballot clerk, provided that delivery by a physically disabled elector may be made by any adult person upon satisfactory proof that such adult person is such elector’s mother, father, grandparent, aunt, uncle, brother, sister, spouse, son, daughter, niece, nephew, grandchild, son-in-law, daughter-in-law, mother-in-law, father-in-law, brother-in-law, sister-in-law or an individual residing in the household of such disabled elector.”

PLEASE REMEMBER THERE IS NO VOTING ON THE MONDAY PRIOR TO ELECTION DAY.

Can I view a sample ballot?

Yes. Sample ballots will be available at the poll on election day. You can also view a sample ballot in the office of the Board of Elections and Voter Registration. Generally, sample ballot copies are distributed among many businesses in the area and a copy is posted on the county website.

What if I need assistance?

If you need assistance because of blindness, physical disability, or the inability to read or read in the English, you may ask for help from either a person of your choice or from election officials.

What if I make a mistake on my ballot?

The voting units explain how to make changes or corrections. If you do not understand, raise your hand and a poll official will assist you.

How do the poll workers know what ballot to give me?

Georgia has an “open” primary system. Voters do not have to declare a
